CASHLESS PAYMENTS FOR SCHOOL DINNERS FOR ALL CHILDREN IN KS2

I am writing to inform you that as your child will be moving to Year 3 from September as from September universal Free School Meals will no longer be applicable for him/her.

All children in Years 3,4,5 & 6 are required to pay for school meals unless you have made an application to receive Free School Meals (FSM). See Mrs Verma to make an application. As of this term we have begun the cashless payment facility through a company named "School Money"– which operates through Taechers2Parents, which in turn is used by the school for sending text and email messages.

The new [Schoolmoney](#) facility allows parents and the catering company to experience a more streamlined, cost-effective and efficient payment collection system in a secure and safe environment.

The system works well only if all records held on our database are correct.

IT IS CRUCIAL WE HAVE CORRECT MOBILE NUMBERS AND EMAIL ADDRESSES.

If both your mobile and email details are correct, you will receive a text with a link to schoolmoney.co.uk and a password given.

You may order a school lunch for your child by choosing from the dinner menu available on schoolmoney.co.uk

To make a payment, all you will be required to do is to:

- Follow the link in the text you receive
- Use the password that is automatically generated
- And follow the instructions to make the payment
