KS2 SPORTS DAY - THURSDAY 6th JULY at VILLIERS HIGH SCHOOL

- **KS2 (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6), start at 12.30pm - Children will walk from Hambrough at 12.00noon after having an early lunch before their sports session at Villiers in the afternoon. They will return to Hambrough at about 3.30pm**

KS1 SPORTS DAY -FRIDAY 7th July at VILLIERS HIGH SCHOOL)

- **KS1 (Reception, Years 1 & 2) - will start at 1.00pm. Children Children will walk from Hambrough at 12.30noon after having an early lunch before their sports session at Villiers in the afternoon. They will return to Hambrough at about 3.30pm**

Please make sure

- KS2 children have their PE kits in school on 6th July.
- KS1 children have their PE kits in school on 7th July.

As the weather is changeable, they should bring a sun hat, apply sun cream before coming to school and also bring a waterproof jacket with them. **ALL CHILDREN MUST BRING WITH THEM AN EXTRA COLD DRINK (NO FIZZY DRINKS/GLASS BOTTLES).**

Parents are more than welcome to come along to support their children on both the Sports Days. However, those parents who wish to come to support will need to gather at the side gate on Villiers field at 12.15 for KS2 (6th July) and 12.45 for KS1 (7th July) and wait for us because the gate will be locked once everyone has arrived - late arrivals will not be allowed through the school.
